NEW THIS YEAR: DIRT CRIT!

The Donkey Head Trophy will be awarded to the first place finisher of the Cat 1-2-3 Men's A race. It is an original work of art donated by local Philadelphia artist Warren Holzman – <http://www.ironstudiold.com>. It promises to be a cherished conversation piece. The feature race has been known for some great showdowns, and we hope having this trophy will continue to attract top caliber talent for an exciting feature race worth staying for.

The Cross Course winds through a defunct nursery from the early 20th century. Observe a plethora of characteristic South Jersey arboreal surroundings ranging from sandy deciduous, ancient pine, to aromatic swamp. The course is flat and—aside from the technical, turny stuff—fast.

The area's first Dirt Crit. Be a part of history! The wide course will have a mix of dirt and grass; some smooth, some rough. No barriers will be used. About 2:30 minute laps. There will be a wheel pit and free lap; USA Cycling Crit Rules will apply.

Register Online at Bikereg.com. Online registration closes on October 1st at 11:59 pm eastern time. Day-of registration opens at 8:00 am and closes 30 minutes before each race. Please use the USCF standard release form. One-day and annual licenses available. Mail-ins must be received by October 1st. Send standard release forms along with a check—made payable to QCW Cycling—to:

No refunds. USCF rules apply. Unlicensed riders need to purchase a one-day license (\$10) to race. \$5 late fee applies for day of registration. Additional registration fees may apply.

Call-ups will be based on NJ Cross Series placing and/or order of registration.

Child Care and Kids Activities are available for kids age 4 and up. Drop off 30 minutes before race starts, pick up 15 minutes after race ends. Kids accompanied by an adult may participate in arts and crafts and other activities free of charge.
