#### Saturday April 24th

**6:30-8:30am - On-site Registration for all events** – Bread parking lot (Please park in Animas Square and Star Liquor lots across the street – Please DO NOT park at the Bread or Pawn Shop parking lots). **Directions:** Take Main Ave. to 32nd St., turn east and road ends at CR250, turn right, Animas Square will second/third entrances and Star Liquor the fourth entrance on your right. (Remember Florida Rd. construction - westbound only – bikes included)

### 8am – Bread/East Animas Team Time Trial – ITT for USAC Categories

**Course-** Start at the intersection of 32nd street and County Road 250 at Core Value Training Center. The course will be a point to point format. Racers will ride north on county road 250 (East side of the Animas Valley) for approximately 25km. The final 2.5km will take racers on a climb up Old Shalona, finishing before the Durango and Silverton Narrow Gage Railroad tracks. Teams will go off in one minute intervals starting at 8am: Men C, Women B, Men B, Women A, Men A. Racers will have to either arrange a pick-up or ride back from the finish of the TTT. If riding back from the finish please follow all rules of the road, as the roads are open to traffic.
